

What is Commit Zenut ?(commit sexual immorality)

The Hebrew word "zenut" refers to sexual immorality or unchastity - actions that go against Torah's teachings about appropriate sexual relationships. Torah emphasizes that intimacy should be expressed within the context of a sacred marriage between a man and a woman, and that we are called to treat our bodies and relationships with respect, dignity, and holiness.

In Jewish tradition, the focus is always on guiding people toward lives of virtue, compassion, and connection to God. When discussing topics related to human relationships and sexuality, Torah's teachings are rooted in care for individuals and communities, emphasizing love, commitment, and responsibility.
