Rev 3:13 **"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the Assemblies."**

vs 12 Him who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My Elohim (מִיְהוָה), and he shall go out no more: and I will write upon him the Name of MY Elohim (מִיְהוָה), and the Name of the city YHWH, [which is] New Yerushalayim, which comes down out of Shamayim from My Elohim (מִיְהוָה): and [I will write upon him] My New Name.

Rev 3:22 **"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the Assemblies."**

vs 21 To him that overcomes will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in His throne.

1. **Life restored** (tree of life)
2. **Death defeated**
