🌟 What “And I saw...” means

In **Hisgalus / Revelation**, the phrase “**And I saw**” appears many times because the whole book is a **series of visions**.

It means:

- The writer is **not describing normal events**
- He is **seeing symbolic visions from heaven**
- Each vision carries **spiritual meaning**, not just literal meaning

📖 **Example: The scroll with seven seals**
(Hisgalus 5)

One part says:

“And I saw... a scroll... sealed with seven seals”

Simple meaning:

- **Scroll (book)** → God’s plan for the future

- **Seven seals** → fully sealed / hidden (no one can open it easily)
- **No one can open it** → humans don't have authority or understanding
- Then comes the key message:
 - Only the **Messiah (the Lamb / Lion of Judah)** is worthy to open it

👉 **Meaning:**

God's ultimate plan (judgment, salvation, future events) can only be revealed and carried out by the Messiah.

🐎 **Example: "And I saw... a white horse" (Hisgalus 6)**

Another vision:

"And I saw... a white horse... going forth conquering"

Simple meaning:

This is symbolic, not just a horse:

- **White horse** → victory / purity
- **Rider with a crown** → authority
- **Going to conquer** → spreading power or influence

Some interpretations say:

- It represents the **spread of truth (Gospel)**
- Others say it represents **conquest or judgment**

👉 Meaning:

It shows **forces moving across the world under God's plan**






🔥 **Big picture of “And I saw...”**

Every time you see **“And I saw”**, think:

- ➔ “A new vision is being shown”
- ➔ “This is symbolic imagery”
- ➔ “It reveals part of God's plan—judgment, warning, or hope”

Easy way to understand it

Instead of reading it literally, read it like this:

-  Scroll → God's hidden plan
-  Horses → events on earth (war, peace, famine, etc.)
-  Crown → authority
-  Fire / plagues → judgment
-  Lamb → Messiah (Jesus)
