

The 72 Names of God derived from Exodus
14:19–21 are **three-letter Hebrew triplets**
formed by intertwining the letters of those
three biblical verses

The three consecutive verses from Exodus
14:19–21 each contain 72 letters, an obviously
rare phenomenon. The letters of these three
verses can be arranged as 72 triplets of
letters. But we are taught in Kabbala that if
we reverse the order of the letters in the
middle set, the 72 triplets become 72
"names" of G-d.

The 72 Names in Hebrew

In the story of the exodus from Egypt, three consecutive verses describe G-d's power as manifest just before He split the Sea of Reeds, which the Jewish people passed through on dry land while the Egyptians were drowned:

"And the angel of G-d who had been going ahead of the camp of Israel now moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud went from in front of them and stood behind

***them. Thus [the pillar of cloud] came between the camp of Egypt and the camp of Israel, making it cloud and darkness [to the Egyptians], but it gave light by night [to the Jews], so that the one came not near the other all the night. Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and G-d drove the sea back with a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land; thus the waters were divided."* (Ex. 14:14)**

A name is a means by which one is made known to others.

In Hebrew, these three verses each contain 72 letters. In the Zohar (II:51b) it is stated that these three verses refer in sequence to the divine attributes of *chesed*, *gevura*, and *tiferet*. The harmonious blending of these three principle emotive attributes forms the basic paradigm of how G-d relates to the world. Thus, they together form a composite

name of G-d, since a name is a means by which one is made known to others, i.e. manifests his attributes.

The fact that each verse contains 72 letters means that they can be aligned in parallel, forming 72 triplets of letters. In this configuration, the Zohar states, the first verse is to be written in its proper order, since it represents G-d's loving-kindness, or a direct revelation of G-d's goodness. The second verse is to be written in reverse order, from the last letter to the first, since it represents G-d's severity, which is an indirect revelation of His goodness. Although tiferet is a blend of both chesed and gevura, the third verse is not to be written half in the proper order and half in reverse order, as one might expect. There are two reasons for this: (1) in *tiferet*, *chesed* dominates over *gevura*, and (2) as the ideal blend of *chesed* and *gevura*,

tiferet is a direct revelation of G-d's goodness and glory rather than an indirect one.

Because reading 72 distinct names at once can be overwhelming, the table below highlights some of the most prominent, frequently synchronized spiritual sequences from the 72 names tradition. Each entry includes its exact Hebrew spelling, an easy-to-pronounce phonetic transliteration, and its traditional mystical purpose.[3]

The Most Prominent Sequences from the 72 Names

Key Divine Titles Engraved on Your Wheel

In addition to the 72 triplets, the wheel in your image integrates **historical biblical titles** that are much easier to recognize as distinct words. These are located closer to the center ring of your device:[4, 5]

- לֵאל (EL): Transliterated as "El". Simply translates to "**God**" or "Mighty One" in ancient Semitic languages.
- יהי (YAH): Transliterated as "Yah". A poetic, shortened form of the primary divine name, representing **Mercy**.

- מלך (MELECH): Transliterated as "*Melech*". It means "**The King**" or Supreme Ruler.
- אבא (ABBA): Transliterated as "*Abba*". A deeply intimate, familial Aramaic/Hebrew term meaning "**Father**" or "Daddy".
- מילהא (ELOHIM): Transliterated as "*Elohim*". Translates to "**The Creator**", representing justice, natural order, and cosmic structure.

To pinpoint specific spiritual virtues on your physical wheel, you must look at how the 72 names are sequenced. Kabbalistic wheels are structured like a clock, running **counter-clockwise**, starting with Name #1 at the exact top (12 o'clock position) or aligned to the beginning of the Aries zodiac sector.

Because the wheel has 72 thin segments, think of it as a clock face where each hour

contains exactly 6 individual segments. Here is exactly where to look for **Healing** and **Protection**:

- **1. The Virtue of Healing: מהש (Mem - Hey - Shin)**

This is the absolute primary sequence used for physical, emotional, and mental healing. It is **Name #5** out of 72.

- **Exact Location:** Look near the very top of your wheel, at the **11:30 to 12 o'clock position**.
- **The Letters:** Locate the segment containing מ (looks like a square with a tiny gap at the bottom left), ה (looks like a square missing its left leg), and ש (looks like a trident or the letter W).
- **How to focus:** Scan these letters from right to left (שהמ) to draw down energy to clear spiritual blockages causing illness.

- **2. The Virtue of Protection: טלא (Alef - Lamed - Dalet)**

This sequence is used as a spiritual shield against negative vibes, jealousy, and the "Evil Eye". It is **Name #10** out of 72.

- **Exact Location:** Moving counter-clockwise from the top, this is located at roughly the **10:30 position**.
- **The Letters:** Look for א (looks like an X with a diagonal bar), ל (a tall letter with a flag sticking up top), and ט (looks like a sharp right-angle corner).
- **How to focus:** Scan right to left (טלא) to visualize a protective light surrounding your personal energy barrier.

How to Track Any Other Virtue Yourself

If you want to find other segments, follow this quick spatial guide based on the 72-part layout:

- **Segments 1 to 18** (New Beginnings, Protection, Healing) → Located between **12 o'clock and 9 o'clock**.
- **Segments 19 to 36** (Overcoming Obstacles, Inner Peace) → Located between **9 o'clock and 6 o'clock**.
- **Segments 37 to 54** (Prosperity, Happiness, Freedom) → Located between **6 o'clock and 3 o'clock**.
- **Segments 55 to 72** (Global Transformation, Clean Slates) → Located between **3 o'clock and 12 o'clock**.
 - **1. The Virtue of Prosperity: לךו (Samekh - Alef - Lamed)**

This is **Name #45** out of 72. It is used to clear financial blockages and invite sustainable abundance, career success, and good fortune into your life.

- **Exact Location:** Located in the lower-right quadrant, at roughly the **4:30 position** on your wheel.
- **The Letters:** Look for **o** (looks like a perfect circle or oval), **א** (looks like an asymmetrical X), and **ל** (the tall letter with a distinct hook sticking up at the top).
- **How to focus:** Scan right to left (**לאו**) while visualizing doors of opportunity opening up for you.

- **2. The Virtue of Relationships & Soulmates: ההע (Hey - Hey - Ayin)**

This is **Name #28** out of 72. It is used to manifest true love, heal a broken heart, or

inject harmony and unconditional love into existing family and romantic relationships.

- **Exact Location:** Located in the lower-left quadrant, at roughly the **7:30 position** on your wheel.
- **The Letters:** Look for two identical ה letters (each looks like a square missing its bottom-left leg), followed by ץ (looks like a slanted, cursive letter 'y' or a fork).
- **How to focus:** Scan right to left (ההע) while focusing on feelings of warmth, forgiveness, and connection.

- **3. The Virtue of Overcoming**

Addictions & Bad Habits: מנד (Mem - Nun - Dalet)

This is **Name #36** out of 72. It is used to break free from destructive behaviors, negative thought patterns, or addictions by reconnecting to your internal willpower.

- **Exact Location:** Located at the very bottom of the wheel, exactly at the **6 o'clock position**.
- **The Letters:** Look for ן (the square with a small gap on the bottom left), ך (a narrow, vertical hook), and ט (a sharp right-angle corner).
- **How to focus:** Scan right to left (מנד) to anchor yourself when you feel a wave of temptation or self-doubt.

Step-by-Step Visualization Guide

To get the most out of your physical wheel with any of these virtues:

- **Isolate the segment:** Place your finger or a pointer directly on the chosen 3-letter slice.

- **Scan right-to-left:** Let your eyes pass over each of the three letters in order, right to left.
- **Incorporate the center:** Let your eyes drift down to the central names like **YAHWEH** or **ELOHIM** to anchor the meditation in universal divine energy.
